**RM40-2020-01, IN THE MATTER OF 15 DCMR CHAPTER 40 – DISTRICT OF
COLUMBIA SMALL GENERATOR INTERCONNECTION RULES,**

and

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1050, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION OF
IMPLEMENTATION OF INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS IN THE DISTRICT OF
COLUMBIA,**

1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that pursuant to Order No. 20991, the Commission will convene the RM40 Advanced Inverter Working Group on December 15, 2021, from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. virtually through Microsoft Teams. In accordance with the Commission’s directives in Order No. 20991, the RM40 Advanced Inverter Working Group will discuss: (1) the establishment of advanced inverter settings profiles and other related matters; (2) timeline for adoption; and (3) delays in the widespread availability of IEEE 1547-2018 certified equipment in the market. Commission Staff shall preside over the working group meeting and file meeting minutes in the above-captioned dockets within 15 days of the meeting.

2. On August 11, 2021, the Commission issued Order No. 20991 and a Notice of Final Rulemaking, which adopted final amendments to Chapter 40 (District of Columbia Small Generator Interconnection Rules) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations. The Commission, *inter alia*, stated that “a stakeholder input process is necessary to further the discussions surrounding the development of the advanced inverter process.” To prompt discussion on this issue, the Commission adopted an initial set of advanced inverter rules, in Subsection 4002.7, which mirrored the Maryland advanced inverter rules. However, the Commission stated that the Advanced Inverter Working Group should be convened “with the goal of . . . finalizing discussions on advanced inverter profiles and other related matters within 120 days from the date of its first meeting.”

3. Persons interested in participating in the RM40 Advanced Inverter Working Group should notify the Commission of their intent to attend no later than noon, December 8, 2021, by sending an email including: (1) the participant’s name and organization, if applicable; and (2) whether the participant or organization will present a PowerPoint or other presentations.
