FORMAL CASE NO. EA11-10, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF UTILITY SAVINGS SOLUTIONS, LLC TO SURRENDER ITS ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER LICENSE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, Order No. 21980

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants the request of Utility Savings Solutions, LLC (“Utility Savings Solutions” or “Applicant”) to surrender its electricity supplier license. Cancellation of the Applicant’s electricity supplier license shall become effective upon the issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On June 15, 2011, the Commission granted Utility Savings Solutions a license to operate as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia (“District”) in Order No. 16398.¹ On April 1, 2024, Utility Savings Solutions filed an Application with the Commission to surrender its electricity supplier license.² Utility Savings Solutions applied for an electricity supplier license with the intent to do business as a broker in the District, but it has not provided any services since acquiring its license.³ Accordingly, Utility Savings Solutions requests to surrender its electricity supplier license in the District.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. According to 15 DCMR § 4602.10 (a)(1), a licensed electricity supplier wishing to cease providing services in the District must provide to the Commission 60 days prior written notice of the licensee’s intention to cease providing electricity service to its customers and inform its customers of the choice to revert to the default service provider or another electricity supplier. Section 4602.10 (a)(2) also requires that the surrendering licensee provide to the Commission an example or copy of the notice it provided to its customers and, upon the Commission’s receipt of

such notice, may order the licensee to provide such further notice to its customers or the public as the Commission deems necessary, and/or take such other action that the Commission considers appropriate.⁵

4. In this case, Utility Savings Solutions’ Application is notice to the Commission of its intention to surrender its electricity supplier license. Utility Savings Solutions states that it has had no previous or current customers in the District to notify of its intent to end business operations or cease providing electric service.⁶ In all other respects, Utility Savings Solutions’ Application substantially conforms with Commission requirements for a surrendering licensee. Commission records reflect the case number, order number, and date the Applicant’s license was granted.⁷ Utility Savings Solutions avers, and Commission records confirm, that the Applicant has no customers nor any jurisdictional revenue and thus owes no assessment amount.⁸ In addition, the Applicant attests it has no outstanding consumer complaints.⁹ Lastly, the Applicant has submitted an affidavit from the managing executive of Utility Savings Solutions attesting to the truth and accuracy of the information submitted.¹⁰

IV. DECISION

5. Based upon the preceding information, the Commission grants Utility Savings Solutions’ request to surrender its electricity supplier license granted by Order No. 16398. Cancellation of Utility Savings Solutions’ supplier license shall become effective upon the issuance of this Order. Should Utility Savings Solutions seek to re-enter the District’s electricity market in the future, it shall have to reapply for an electricity supplier license pursuant to Chapter 46 of the Commission’s rules.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. The request of Utility Savings Solutions, LLC to surrender its electricity supplier license is **GRANTED**; and

7. Cancellation of Utility Savings Solutions, LLC's electricity supplier license shall become effective upon issuance of this Order.
