ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2024-04, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
AMERICAN POWER & GAS OF DC, LLC FOR AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER
LICENSE, Order No. 21995**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to American Power & Gas of DC, LLC (“AP&G” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ American Power & Gas of DC, LLC’s license is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On March 28, 2024, AP&G filed its license application.² Specifically, AP&G intends to operate as a marketer of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. AP&G filed supplemental information on April 30, 2024.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in AP&G’s application and supplemental filing demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve electricity customers

in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting AP&G's application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, AP&G's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of American Power & Gas of DC, LLC for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. American Power & Gas of DC, LLC's license is effective upon issuance of this Order.
