NOTICE OF FINAL TARIFF**FORMAL CASE NO. 1017, IN THE MATTER OF THE DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGNATION OF STANDARD OFFER SERVICE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,**

1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (Commission) hereby gives notice, pursuant to Section 34-802 of the District of Columbia Official Code and in accordance with Section 2-505 of the District of Columbia Official Code,<sup>1</sup> of its final tariff action to approve the Potomac Electric Power Company's (Pepco or Company) proposed Standard Offer Service (SOS) – Rider SOS tariff amendment.

2. On July 1, 2024, Pepco filed a proposed Rider SOS.<sup>2</sup> On July 3, 2024, Pepco filed an errata updating and correcting Attachment G.<sup>3</sup> On July 23, 2024, Pepco filed a second errata replacing Attachment G that was filed on July 3, 2024.<sup>4</sup> Pepco's proposed tariff amendment updates the retail transmission rates included in the Rider SOS "... to reflect the current Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approved wholesale transmission rates, which went into effect June 1, 2024."<sup>5</sup>

3. Pepco stated that the current Pepco Zone FERC-approved wholesale transmission rates for the period June 1, 2024, through May 31, 2025, include three (3) items: 1) Pepco and the Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative's FERC-approved formula rates as delineated in Attachment H-9A and Attachment H-9C of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT); 2) Transmission Enhancement Charges pursuant to Schedule 12 of the PJM OATT; and 3) the impact of changes to the PJM OATT pursuant to the FERC Order issued on May 31, 2018, in FERC Docket No. EL05-121-009.<sup>6</sup> Pepco estimates the impact of its proposed change in retail transmission rates to a Residential SOS customer using six hundred thirty-two (632) kWh per month to be an increase of \$2.50 per month.<sup>7</sup>

4. Pepco's proposal will amend the following thirteen (13) tariff pages, which contain the revised retail transmission rates:

5. On July 19, 2024, the Commission published a Notice of Proposed Tariff (NOPT) in the *D.C. Register*, inviting public comments for a thirty (30) day period on Pepco's Rider SOS.<sup>8</sup> On August 2, 2024, the Commission published a second NOPT in the *D.C. Register*, inviting public comments for a thirty (30) day period on Pepco's Rider SOS.<sup>9</sup> No comments were filed in response to the NOPT.

6. The Commission, at its regularly scheduled open meeting held on October 9, 2024, approved Pepco's proposed tariff amendment that updates the Company's retail transmission rates

consistent with the current FERC-approved wholesale transmission rates. This amendment will become effective upon publication of this Notice of Final Tariff in the *D.C. Register*.
