ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2024-07, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
THE POWER COMPANY USA, LLC FOR AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER
LICENSE, Order No. 22336**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to The Power Company USA, LLC (“Power Company USA” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ The Power Company USA, LLC’s license is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On October 15, 2024, Power Company USA filed its license application.² Specifically, Power Company USA intends to operate as a broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. Power Company USA filed supplemental information on October 16, 17, and November 15, 2024.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in Power Company USA’s application and supplemental filings demonstrate that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to

serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting Power Company USA's application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, Power Company USA's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of The Power Company USA, LLC for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The Power Company USA, LLC's license is effective upon issuance of this Order.
