ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2024-08, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
RESCOM ENERGY, LLC D/B/A NEXTVOLT ENERGY FOR AN
ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER LICENSE, Order No. 22337**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to ResCom Energy LLC d/b/a NextVolt Energy (“NextVolt Energy” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ ResCom Energy LLC d/b/a NextVolt Energy’s license is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On October 15, 2024, NextVolt Energy filed its license application.² Specifically, NextVolt Energy intends to operate as a marketer of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. NextVolt Energy filed supplemental information on October 16, 17, and November 15, 2024.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in NextVolt Energy’s application and supplemental filings demonstrate that it has met all the prescribed licensing

requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting NextVolt Energy's application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, NextVolt Energy's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of ResCom Energy LLC d/b/a NextVolt Energy for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. ResCom Energy LLC d/b/a NextVolt Energy's license is effective upon issuance of this Order.
