ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2024-11, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
ARBOR ENERGY BROKERAGE SERVICES LLC FOR AN ELECTRICITY
SUPPLIER LICENSE, Order No. 22386**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to Arbor Energy Brokerage Services LLC (“AEBS” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ The license for Arbor Energy Brokerage Services LLC is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On November 7, 2024, AEBS filed its license application.² Specifically, AEBS intends to operate as an aggregator/broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. AEBS filed supplemental information on December 6, 2024, January 7, January 24, and March 5, 2025.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in AEBS’ application and supplemental filings demonstrate that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements

and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting AEBS' application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, AEBS' application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of Arbor Energy Brokerage Services LLC for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The license for Arbor Energy Brokerage Services LLC is effective upon issuance of this Order.
