ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2025-02, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
LEAPFROG POWER, INC. FOR AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER LICENSE,
Order No. 22430**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to Leapfrog Power, Inc. (“Leapfrog” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ The license for Leapfrog Power, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On February 26, 2025, Leapfrog filed its license application.² Specifically, Leapfrog intends to operate as a broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. Leapfrog filed supplemental information on March 24, 2025, April 23, 2025, and May 15, 2025.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in Leapfrog’s application and supplemental filings demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve

electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting Leapfrog's application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, Leapfrog's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of Leapfrog Power, Inc. for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The license for Leapfrog Power, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.
