The PJM Capacity Auction Task Force met on June 26, 2025, for their ninth meeting in Formal Case No. 1183. In attendance were representatives from Pepco, OPC, PJM Interconnection, AOBA, Staff, DOEE, and DCG.

Introduction/Attendance

Attendance was taken. OPC went over the agenda, which is attached.

Discussion of Report Draft Sections

Parties discussed draft sections of the Report, specifically Section 1 and Section 2. Parties provided comments and some initial thoughts and edits. Parties will provide written edits to OPC for Section 1 & 2 by July 3rd, 2025. In addition, each party can choose to draft what it has specifically done with respect to education and outreach for Section 2 and forward this to OPC to include under Section 2. Parties are to get this write-up to OPC by July 3rd as well.¹

Next Steps

OPC will provide a second draft, which will incorporate edits and merge the two sections, to the task force by July 11, 2025.

The parties discussed addressing Section 3. OPC suggested adding a brief statement, citing to the recent Commission Order, and that task members could also add anything additional here. Pepco indicated that a footnote would likely be sufficient and could explain that this section would be covered in the October Report per the recent Commission Order.
