ORDER UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY

September 30, 2025

FORMAL CASE NOS. EA2023-12 AND GA2023-08, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF INSIGHT ENERGY, LLC TO SURRENDER ITS ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER LICENSE AND NATURAL GAS SUPPLIER LICENSE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, Order No. 22717

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order,¹ the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants the request of Insight Energy, LLC (“Insight” or “Applicant”) to surrender its electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license. Cancellation of Insight’s electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license is effective upon the issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On March 22, 2024, in Order No. 21974, the Commission granted Insight a license to operate as a natural gas supplier in the District of Columbia (“District”).² The Commission granted Insight a license to operate as an electricity supplier on May 2, 2024, in Order No. 21989.³ On September 15, 2025, Insight filed an application with the Commission requesting to surrender its electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license.⁴ Insight was approved to operate as a broker of electricity and natural gas services in the District, but it has been acquired by a separate entity and no longer conducts business in the District.⁵ Consequently, Insight requests to

surrender its electricity license and natural gas supplier license.⁶

III. DISCUSSION

3. According to 15 DCMR § 4602.10 (a)(1) and § 4702.10 (a)(1), a licensed electricity supplier and natural gas supplier wishing to cease providing services in the District is required to provide written notice to the Commission of the licensee's intention to cease providing electricity and natural gas service to its customers and inform its customers of the choice to revert to the default service provider or another electricity and natural gas supplier. Sections 4602.10 (a)(2) and 4702.10 (a)(2) also require that the surrendering licensee provide to the Commission an example or copy of the notice it provided to its customers and, upon the Commission's receipt of such notice, may order the licensee to provide such further notice to its customers or to the public as the Commission deems necessary, and/or take such other action that the Commission deems appropriate.⁷

4. In the instant case, Insight's Application serves as notice to the Commission that it has ceased providing services in the District and of its intent to surrender its electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license. Insight states that it has no customers and thus has no customers to whom notice can be provided.⁸ Inasmuch as Insight has no customers in the District, no notice to customers with regard to the cessation of service and the opportunity to revert to a default supplier is necessary.⁹ In all other aspects, Insight's Application conforms with Commission requirements for a surrendering licensee. Specifically, it has provided the formal case numbers, order numbers, and dates its licenses were approved.¹⁰ The Applicant asserts, and Commission records confirm, that the Applicant's most recent survey responses indicate no jurisdictional revenue and thus it owes no outstanding debt or fees.¹¹ In addition, the Applicant asserts that it has no outstanding consumer complaints against it.¹² Lastly, the Applicant has submitted an affidavit from an officer of the company attesting to the truth and accuracy of the information submitted.¹³

5. Based upon the preceding information, the Commission grants the request of Insight to surrender its electricity supplier license granted by Order No. 21989, and its natural gas supplier license granted by Order No. 21974. Cancellation of Insight's supplier licenses shall become effective upon the issuance of this Order. Should Insight seek to reenter the District's electricity and natural gas market in the future, it shall have to reapply for a supplier license in accordance with Chapters 46 and 47 of the Commission's rules.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. The request of Insight Energy, LLC to surrender its electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license is **GRANTED**; and

7. Cancellation of Insight Energy, LLC's electricity supplier license and natural gas supplier license is effective upon the issuance of this Order.
