ORDER UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY

February 11, 2026

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA2026-01, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
GATBY VENTURES, INC. FOR AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER LICENSE, Order No.
22790**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order,¹ the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to Gatby Ventures, Inc. (“Gatby Ventures” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.² The license for Gatby Ventures, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On January 8, 2026, Gatby Ventures filed its license application.³ Specifically, Gatby Ventures intends to operate as an aggregator/broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.⁴ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. Gatby Ventures filed supplemental information on January 27, 2026.⁵

III. DISCUSSION & DECISION

3. Our review of the information contained in Gatby Ventures' application and supplemental filing demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting Gatby Ventures' application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, Gatby Ventures' application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of Gatby Ventures, Inc. for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. The license for Gatby Ventures, Inc. is effective upon issuance of this Order.
