**INTEGRATED NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM PLANNING WORKING
GROUP – JULY 29, 2026 MINUTES**

The first meeting of the Integrated Natural Gas Distribution System Planning Working Group was held virtually from 9:00 am – 9:40 am. There were representatives from the following entities:

Office of the People’s Counsel for the District of Columbia
District of Columbia Government/Department of Energy and Environment

Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia staff

Summary of Discussion

Commission staff indicated that the purpose of this first meeting was to establish the meeting cadence and discuss the subject matter of the meetings. Commission staff noted that the INGDSP WG is intended to identify areas of consensus and disagreement for the Commission. Although consensus is encouraged where possible, the INGDSP WG is not expected to reach agreement on every issue. After discussion, the participants agreed to schedule meetings on a generally biweekly cadence, on Thursdays from noon – 2:00 p.m., beginning on August 20. The third meeting would be on August 27. Commission staff will send out invitations for virtual meetings and sought contact information for additional participants.

The parties agreed that the August, September, and early October meetings will focus on a specific topic to be identified by Commission staff and the parties. By close of business on the Tuesday before the meeting, parties will circulate brief written summaries of their positions on the upcoming topic to the other parties to facilitate discussion at the meeting. The later meetings will focus on the INGDSP WG Report.

Minutes will be prepared by the parties in a rotating order: WGL; OPC; DCG; and Sierra Club. The minutes will contain any consensus achieved and summaries of areas in which there is disagreement. Draft minutes will be circulated to the parties a week after the meeting for review and editing before filing in the *Formal Case No. 1187* docket two weeks after the meeting.

WGL will prepare the first draft of the INGDSP WG Report. Parties will have a chance to review and edit the Report before filing. The Report may include a list of next steps for the Commission

to consider. The participants also discussed the possibility of requesting a brief extension of the filing deadline, if necessary, and agreed to revisit that issue later in the process. A brief extension may be necessary since the filing deadline is December 1, 2026.
