THROUGH NOPV19-29-F)**

Pursuant to 15 DCMR § §105.8 and 117.5, the Public Service Commission for the District of Columbia's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, Washington Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas" or "Company") respectfully requests an extension to file Notice of Remedial Action Completion.

1. Pursuant to the Notice of Probable Violations ("NOPVs") dated December 2, 2019, the Company has within 5 days of completion of remedial actions to file a notice of remedial action completion with the Commission's Office of Compliance and Enforcement.

2. Unfortunately, the Company's Manager of DOT Pipeline Safety and Compliance who reviews and assists with preparing the Notice of Remedial Action Completion has been inundated with work and needs until February 5, 2020 to complete the Notice of Remedial Actions.

4. Thus, the Company is requesting an extension to file its Notice of Remedial Action Completion until Wednesday, February 5, 2020.

Therefore, based upon the, reasons stated above, the Company requests the Office of Compliance and Enforcement grant the Company an extension until February 5, 2020 to file a Notice of Remedial Action Completion for the above-entitled NOPVs.

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
