Pursuant to 15 DCMR § §105.8 and 117.5, the Public Service Commission for the District of Columbia's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, Washington Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas" or "Company") respectfully requests an extension to file Notice of Remedial Action Completion.

- 1. Pursuant to the Notice of Probable Violations ("NOPVs") dated December 2, 2019, the Company has within 5 days of completion of remedial actions to file a notice of remedial action completion with the Commission's Office of Compliance and Enforcement.
