PETITION TO INTERVENE

As grounds for this petition to intervene, GSA states as follows:

1. The Federal Property and Administrative Services Act, 40 U.S.C. §501(c), requires GSA to represent the consumer interests of the federal executive agencies in proceedings before state regulatory bodies.
2. The federal executive agencies have a substantial interest in this proceeding because they own and operate numerous buildings and facilities within the District of Columbia and annually purchase millions of dollars of electricity, including natural gas. No other party has the statutory authority or capacity to represent the federal government’s interests.
