6. Actions Against Licensee

Pennsylvania: On October 21, 2010, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission granted Applicant a License for Electric Generation Supplier as a broker/marketer in the matter of the application of A-2010-2179537. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issued an order cancelling EMEX’s electric generation supplier license # A-2010-2179537 on July 16, 2019, for failure to provide proof of financial security (the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission requires all licensed electric generation suppliers to furnish the original bond demonstrating financial security). However, EMEX immediately filed a

Petition for Reconsideration of this cancellation based on the fact that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's request for the bond was sent to the wrong regulatory contact so EMEX had no notice of the request or the pending cancellation. Furthermore, the required security bond has been in place continuously with no interruption. On August 8, 2019, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission granted EMEX's Petition for Reconsideration, pending review of the merits of the Petition. This matter was favorably resolved with EMEX being issued electric generation license # A-2019-3014305 on December 19, 2019
