NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE ON VIRTUAL HEARINGS

June 10, 2020

FORMAL CASE NO. 1156, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF POTOMAC ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT A MULTIYEAR RATE PLAN FOR ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

1. On May 20, 2020, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) updated the procedural schedule in which the Commission scheduled a Prehearing Conference and an evidentiary hearing regarding the Potomac Electric Power Company’s Application requesting authority to increase rates and charges for electric service through the implementation of a Multiyear Rate Plan for its electric distribution service in the District of Columbia.¹

2. The Commission hereby gives Notice that both hearings will be convened virtually via Webex. On Thursday, June 11, 2020, Commission Staff will host a virtual meeting to discuss the technological and procedural processes for upcoming conferences and hearings in this proceeding. This virtual meeting will convene at 2:00 p.m.
