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Re: **Formal Case No. 1142, *In the Matter of the Merger Application of AltaGas Ltd. and WGL Holdings, Inc.***

Dear Ms. Westbrook-Sedgwick:

AltaGas Ltd (“AltaGas”) and Washington Gas Light Company (“Washington Gas”) respectfully file this letter in response to Sierra Club’s August 4, 2020 correspondence regarding the July 29, 2020 public meeting on the Climate Business Plan.

As explained in its July 31, 2020 correspondence on this same subject, AltaGas and Washington Gas hosted its July 29, 2020 virtual public community meeting in order to “to report on and discuss its progress on the” Climate Business Plan (the “Plan”) in accordance with Commitment Term No. 79 of Commission Order 19396, Appendix A.¹ As has been the case for all events and large gatherings in the District of Columbia since March, the COVID-19 pandemic prevented the public meeting from occurring in a setting and format that both AltaGas and interested parties would have anticipated.² Nevertheless, the Companies took significant steps to ensure that its virtual public meeting resembled the format of an in-person meeting as much as possible despite the present circumstances.

Unfortunately, the tone of Sierra Club’s correspondence is dismissive of the Companies’ good faith attempt to hold a public meeting despite challenging circumstances and is transparently influenced by Sierra Club’s desire to have Washington Gas cease all gas distribution services in the District. Both AltaGas and Washington Gas nevertheless remain committed to holding substantive and transparent public meetings in compliance with the Commission’s Merger Order 19396. Nearly 200 participants, representing a diverse array of interested parties, including members of the Commission’s technical staff, attended the meeting.³ As the Companies advised in their July 31, 2020 letter, “participants submitted written questions to the panel on a wide variety of topics regarding the Plan in real time to which the panel responded.” Despite Sierra Club’s

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claims to contrary, senior leaders of Washington Gas and ICF Resources, the independent consultant who assisted in developing the Plan, answered, in substance, every question or topic area that were asked regarding the Plan.⁴ Those questions were collated from participant submissions and questions that arose from filed comments. The format included muting the attendees' lines and using the 'Q&A' and 'Chat' features to submit questions (to separate 'cross talk' between participants and actual questions to the panel). This was done to facilitate, not impede, the transparency and effectiveness of the virtual meeting, and is typical when a large number of attendees are invited/expected.

Importantly, contrary to Sierra Club's claims, none of the panelists provided the public with any false or misleading information during their presentations or in response to questions from the public. Sierra Club's skewed interpretations of the Companies' presentation and responses to questions take matters out of context, improperly label differences of opinion as falsehoods, and do not advance an honest discussion of the Climate Business Plan. In their August 4, 2020 correspondence, Sierra Club materially misrepresents a panelist's response to a question regarding indoor air quality and then subsequently uses it to undermine the credibility and integrity of the panelist and the Companies. In another example cited in the same letter, Sierra Club falsely claims that the moderator of the panel "dismissed" studies regarding fossil fuel gas alternatives cited in one question and then asked his own question instead. This plainly did not occur. The moderator acknowledged the national study that was cited in the question, added, for context, that ICF Resources had performed a regional study, and then restated the question.

The Companies are in the process of posting a complete audio file recording of the public meeting which will be made available shortly to the public on the Companies' Climate Business Plan website.⁵ Further, in order to avoid in the future the type of false accusations asserted by Sierra Club, the Companies are current looking into technology for the next meeting (should it be necessary to conduct the next meetings virtually) that will allow the Companies to post in real time all submitted questions as the meeting is progressing and to create a video recording of the meetings for the public to view.

Finally, as indicated during the public meeting, AltaGas encourages and is receptive to participant feedback as to how the format of the public meeting can be improved should the COVID-19 pandemic require further virtual meetings. The Companies look forward to continued
