ORDER

**FORMAL CASE NO. EA 2020-09, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION
OF XENCOM GREEN ENERGY, LLC FOR AN ELECTRICITY SUPPLIER
LICENSE, Order No. 20646**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to Xencom Green Energy, LLC (“Xencom Green Energy” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ Xencom Green Energy, LLC’s license is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On September 21, 2020, Xencom Green Energy filed its license application.² Specifically, Xencom Green Energy intends to operate as a broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. Xencom Green Energy filed supplemental information on October 7 and 15, 2020.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in Xencom Green Energy’s application and supplemental filings demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed

licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and the financial integrity to serve electricity customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting Xencom Green Energy's application will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, Xencom Green Energy's application is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. The application of Xencom Green Energy, LLC for a license to conduct business in the District of Columbia as an electricity supplier is hereby **GRANTED**. Xencom Green Energy, LLC's license is effective upon issuance of this Order.
