PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD EXTENSION UNTIL NOVEMBER 24, 2020

RM41-2020-02, DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA STANDARD OFFER SERVICE RULES,

1. By this Public Notice, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) informs interested persons of an extension of time to file comments in response to a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (“NOPR”) published in this proceeding on September 25, 2020, in the *D.C. Register*.¹

2. The proposed amendments to Chapter 41 (District of Columbia Standard Offer Service (SOS) Rules), of Title 15 (Public Utilities and Cable Television) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) amend Sections 4100-4104, 4106-4108, 4111, and 4199 of the Commission’s SOS rules in order to accommodate the integration of long-term renewable energy power purchase agreements (PPA) into the District’s SOS procurement portfolio. In addition, this NOPR provides a new Section, 4112, governing the procurement of a portion of SOS load through long-term renewable energy PPAs. The procurement of a target quantity of five (5) percent of SOS load through long-term renewable energy power PPA(s) is a pilot project which is still currently under development, and delivery of this renewable energy to SOS customers is not anticipated to begin until June 1, 2024. Through this Public Notice, the Commission extends the comment period from October 26, 2020, to November 24, 2020.
