PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF VIRTUAL HEARING

November 17, 2020

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1162, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
WASHINGTON GAS LIGHT COMPANY FOR AUTHORITY TO INCREASE EXISTING
RATES AND CHARGES FOR GAS SERVICE,**

Through this Public Notice, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) suspends the virtual evidentiary hearing regarding Washington Gas Light Company’s (“WGL”) Application requesting authority to increase existing rates and charges for natural gas service in the District of Columbia that was scheduled to begin on November 18, 2020.¹ WGL, the Office of the People’s Counsel for the District of Columbia, the Apartment and Office Building Association of Metropolitan Washington, and the District of Columbia Government (“Parties”) request suspension of the evidentiary hearings scheduled to commence on November 18, 2020, in the above-referenced proceeding. These Parties have reached an agreement in principle to settle this case and intend to file a settlement agreement for approval by the Commission. The Environmental Defense Fund, U.S. General Services Administration and Sierra Club have represented that they do not oppose suspension of the hearings.² Accordingly, by this notice the Commission suspends the evidentiary hearing.
