**SENIOR CITIZENS AND DISABLED RESIDENTS RATE CLASS
MARCH 22, 2021 TECHNICAL CONFERENCE**

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1149, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE
STRUCTURE AND APPLICATION OF AN EXPERIMENTAL RATE CLASS FOR BOTH
SENIOR CITIZENS AND DISABLED RESIDENTS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,**

On November 8, 2018, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) established a new experimental electricity rate class credit for both senior citizens and disabled residents within the District of Columbia.¹ The experimental rate credit initially restricted those residents who receive the D.C. Homestead Deduction and Senior Citizen/Disabled Property Tax reduction, and are Potomac Electric Power Company customers not receiving the Residential Aid Discount. Given stakeholders’ discussion and interest to include renters in the experimental customer class, the Commission directed Staff to convene another technical conference to further explore and report back to the Commission options for expanding the senior citizens and disabled resident customer class population to include renters, for year 2 of the experimental rate. Thus, in accordance with Commission directives, a Technical Conference is scheduled for Monday, March 22, 2021, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The Technical Conference will be held virtually via Microsoft Teams.
