**WASHINGTON GAS LIGHT COMPANY'S
REPORT ON CERTIFIED GAS ACTIVITIES**

Pursuant to Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") Order No. 21128, issued on March 11, 2022, in Docket PGC Audit 2021-01, Washington Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas" or "Company") hereby submits its Report on Certified Gas ("CG") Activities. Order No. 21128 directed the Company,

to file plans with the Commission, in *Formal Case Nos. 874 and 1167*, on a proactive basis, regarding the evolution in its use of certified and renewable natural gas since these types of gas will play a major part in WGL's future Climate Business Plan and Climate Action Program. WGL should include in its filings, among other things, when: (1) the Company negotiates and executes a contract with a [CG] or RNG supplier; and (2) when [CG] or RNG begins to flow through the system."¹

Washington Gas submits this report in compliance with the Commission's directives.

The Company has finalized contracting for its initial CG purchases, as described below. This report represents a revision to the initial contracting terms contained in the Company's September 9, 2022 filing on this matter. The gas will flow November 2022-March 2023.
