## WASHINGTON GAS LIGHT COMPANY'S REPORT ON CERTIFIED GAS ACTIVITIES

Pursuant to Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission")

Order No. 21128, issued on March 11, 2022, in Docket PGC Audit 2021-01, Washington

Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas" or "Company") hereby submits its Report on

Certified Gas ("CG") Activities. Order No. 21128 directed the Company,

to file plans with the Commission, in *Formal Case Nos. 874 and 1167*, on a proactive basis, regarding the evolution in its use of certified and renewable natural gas since these types of gas will play a major part in WGL's future Climate Business Plan and Climate Action Program. WGL should include in its filings, among other things, when: (1) the Company negotiates and executes a contract with a [CG] or RNG supplier; and (2) when [CG] or RNG begins to flow through the system."<sup>1</sup>

Washington Gas submits this report in compliance with the Commission's directives.

The Company has finalized contracting for its initial CG purchases, as described below. This report represents a revision to the initial contracting terms contained in the Company's September 9, 2022 filing on this matter. The gas will flow November 2022-March 2023.
