ORDER UNDER DELEGATED AUTHORITY

July 2, 2026

**FORMAL CASE NO. GA2012-11, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF
VIRIDIAN ENERGY PA, LLC TO SURRENDER ITS NATURAL GAS SUPPLIER
LICENSE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, Order No. 22895**

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order,¹ the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants the request of Viridian Energy PA, LLC (“Viridian” or “Applicant”) to surrender its natural gas supplier license. Cancellation of the Applicant’s natural gas supplier license is effective upon the issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On November 16, 2012, the Commission granted Viridian a license to operate as a natural gas supplier in the District of Columbia (“District”) in Order No. 16966.² On June 5, 2026, Viridian filed an Application with the Commission to surrender its natural gas supplier license.³ Viridian was approved to operate as a marketer of natural gas services, but it conducts no business and has no natural gas customers in the District.⁴ Consequently, Viridian requests to surrender its natural gas supplier license.⁵

III. DISCUSSION

3. According to 15 DCMR § 4702.10 (a)(1), a licensed natural gas supplier wishing to cease providing services in the District is required to provide written notice to the Commission of the licensee's intention to cease providing natural gas service to its customers and inform its customers of the choice to revert to the default service provider or another natural gas supplier. Section 4702.10 (a)(2) also requires that the surrendering licensee provide to the Commission an example or copy of the notice provided to its customers and, upon the Commission's receipt of such notice, may order the licensee to provide such further notice to its customers or the public as the Commission deems necessary, and/or take such other action that the Commission considers appropriate.⁶

4. In the instant case, TES's Application provides the required notice to the Commission of its intention to surrender its natural gas supplier license, effective immediately.⁷ Viridian also states that because it provides no natural gas service to customers in the District, the notice requirement is inapplicable.⁸ Accordingly, Viridian's Application satisfies the notice requirement with regard to the cessation of service.

5. In all other respects, Viridian's Application conforms with Commission requirements for a surrendering licensee. The Applicant has provided the case number, order number, and the date the Applicant's license was granted.⁹ Viridian avers, and Commission records confirm, that the Applicant's most recent survey response indicates no jurisdictional revenue and that it owes no outstanding debt or fees.¹⁰ In addition, the Applicant attests that it has no outstanding consumer complaints.¹¹ Lastly, the Applicant has submitted an affidavit from an officer of Viridian attesting to the truth and accuracy of the information submitted.¹²

6. Based upon the preceding information, the Commission grants Viridian's request to surrender its natural gas supplier license granted by Order No. 16966. Cancellation of Viridian's natural gas supplier license will take effect upon the issuance of this Order. Should Viridian seek to re-enter the District's natural gas market in the future, it shall have to reapply for a natural gas supplier license pursuant to Chapter 47 of the Commission's rules.

8. Cancellation of Viridian Energy PA, LLC's natural gas supplier license is effective upon the issuance of this Order.
