QUESTION NO. 1

PLEASE EXPLAIN HOW PEPCO'S RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA CAN USE GREEN BUTTON CONNECT MY DATA TO SHARE THEIR INTERVAL USAGE DATA WITH SERVICE PROVIDERS.

RESPONSE:

Pepco's residential customers can authorize a service provider (or a distributed energy company) to access their interval usage data either electronically through My Account or via a signed "Customer Usage Information Authorization" paper form.

QUESTION NO. 2

PLEASE EXPLAIN HOW SERVICE PROVIDERS CAN QUALIFY WITH PEPCO IN ORDER TO MAKE USE OF GREEN BUTTON CONNECT TO OBTAIN THE INTERNAL USAGE DATA OF RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS THEY WISH TO SERVE.

RESPONSE:

Any service provider (e.g., distributed energy company) can apply to register as a third party contractor in the "Customer Request Usage" secured web portal, through which the service provider can access authorized customer interval data.

Service providers may download the electronic authorization form from the Request Customer Usage module of the Online Net Energy Metering Application Web Portal, fill out the form in its entirety, obtain the customer's signature and authorization, and then upload the form back to the Web Portal. Pepco personnel review the authorization form for completeness and grant access, if appropriate, for the service provider to obtain the customer historical data. However, the service provider must have pre-registered its company in the Online Net Energy Metering Application Web Portal. After the service provider is authorized to view the customer's data, it can log into the secure Portal to download up to 12 months of historical customer data.

There is also a paper authorization form option available to service providers.
