ORDER

RPS 2019-278, RPS 2019-294 THROUGH RPS 2019-300, AND RPS 2019-302 THROUGH RPS 2019-310, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF SOL SYSTEMS FOR CERTIFICATION OF SEVENTEEN SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES AS RENEWABLE ENERGY STANDARDS GENERATING FACILITIES, Order No. 19926

- On April 3 and 5, 2019, Sol Systems filed applications for certification of seventeen solar energy facilities located in the Washington, D.C. and Maryland as eligible District of Columbia renewable energy standards generating facilities.¹ The applications indicate that the facilities are behind-the-meter generator and contain all the necessary information required for certification under the Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard rules.²
- 2. Sol Systems must register the facilities with the Generation Attribute Tracking System ("GATS") of the PJM Environmental Information Services, Inc. In addition, pursuant to Commission Rule 2903.3, a behind-the-meter generator must record the Renewable Energy Credits it creates in GATS at least once each calendar year.³ Finally, pursuant to Commission Rule 2903.4, the Solar Renewable Energy Credits generated by these facilities beginning on or after January 1, 2019 may be sold and used for compliance purposes.⁴
