Dear Ms. Westbrook-Sedgwick:

Under Merger Commitment No. 56, Washington Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas") agreed to complete its Leak Survey Mobile Mapping Program ("Mobile Leak Survey" or "MLS"). In May of 2019, Washington Gas completed its MLS application. The application imports work from Washington Gas's compliance work management program and allows leak survey technicians to complete work on a ruggedized tablet in the field. The MLS application tracks and stores the technician's GPS location throughout the survey, thereby ensuring that the technician is within proximity of the underground facilities that are being leak surveyed. Technicians who find indications of natural gas then determine if there is a leak and grade it according to standard procedures. Graded leaks are then entered into the MLS application by the technician at that time, which automatically creates a follow-up order for remediation of the leak in Washington Gas's compliance work management system. The Leak Survey process will still report the location, nature, and grade of leak, as has been done in the past. The MLS application will now verify the technician's location and eliminate paper forms and manual handoffs in the Leak Survey process.
